Start with the the Introduction:

- God + come to my assistance, Make haste to help me.
- Or Invitatory If this is the first prayer of your day

- Go to 4-Week Psalter for the Liturgical Week and Day and Time of day
- NEVER SKIP the Hymn (choose one: pp 659 666)
- Psalmody: 3 Psalms with antiphons, doxology, Psalm prayers
  - [During Advent/Christmas and Lent/Easter, there is only one Antiphon for the Psalmody]
  - Short Pause after each Psalm

- Short Pause, silence, for reflection
- Concluding Prayer
- Acclamation: Let us praise the Lord, And give him thanks

- DID YOU NOTICE: Only one set of Psalms were given for the Daytime Prayer
- If you do another daytime prayer, Use
   Complementary Psalms p 1291

- Start p858
  - Intro
  - Hymn, choose one
  - Psalmody: Psalms 119, 40-I, 40-II, with their Antiphons, +/- Psalm Prayers

- Acclamation, p668
  - Let us praise the Lord, and give him thanks.

- Use Complementary Psalter, p1293
- Start 858
  - Intro
  - Hymn, choose one
  - Midday Complementary Psalmody, p1293
    Psalms 123, 124, 125
