OFFICE OF READINGS

- GILH §55 69 (V-1, pp46-48)
- Note §59 may be prayed at <u>ANY</u> TIME (hour) of the day

- Instructions on page 651
- * **Proper of Seasons begins p 31
- CAN BE PRAYED AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY

Pattern of Office of Readings:

- Introduction
- Hymn
- Psalmody = 3 Psalms
- Verse (2 lines)
- * Scriptural Reading
- Responsory

- * Non-Scriptural Reading
- Responsory
- * SUNDAYS & SOLEMNITIES: Te Deum, p652
- Concluding Prayer
- * Acclamation [Let us praise the Lord, and give him thanks]

- Go to the 4-week Psalter for the Liturgical Week and Day
 - < SKIP the saint days for now>

- Start with the Introduction if it is NOT your first prayer:
 - God + come to my assistance, Lord, make haste to help me.
- [OR Start with the Invitatory (See lesson 2) IF Evening Prayer is the <u>first</u> prayer of your day]

- Go to the 4-week Psalter for the Liturgical Week and Day
- NEVER SKIP the Hymn
- Psalmody: 3 Psalms,
 - OR 2 -3 parts of Psalms (ex, p1121-1122)
 - Psalm = Antiphon + Psalm,
 Doxology + (Psalm Prayer) +
 repeat Antiphon
 - Short Pause after each Psalm
- 2 line verse



Antiphon

- Go to: Proper of Seasons (starts p31, readings on p53)
 - Reading 1: Scripture Reading
 - Responsory
 - * Short Pause, silence, for reflection

- Reading 2: Non- Scripture Reading
- Responsory
- Short Pause, silence, for reflection

- IF SUNDAY OR SOLEMNITY: Pray the Te Deum (p652-653)
- Acclamation (p654)
 - Let us praise the Lord,
 - - and give him thanks.

- Invitatory OR Introduction:
 - Lord (+) open my lips...
 - Antiphon, p649
 - Psalm 95
 - repeat Antiphon
 - OR God (+) come to my assistance...

 - Hymn "O God of truth, prepare our minds..."
 - * Psalmody: Ps 6, Ps 9A-I, Ps 9A-II

- First Reading (Scripture)
- Responsory
- Second Reading (non-Scripture)
- Responsory
- Concluding Prayer, p297
- Acclamation: Let us praise the Lord, and give him thanks (p654)

- * Invitatory OR Introduction:
 - Lord (+) open my lips...
 - Antiphon, p649
 - Psalm 95
 - Antiphon
 - OR God (+) come to my assistance...
- Office of Readings, p827
 - Hymn "Holy, holy, holy,..."
 - Psalmody: Ps 104-I, Ps 104-II,
 Ps 104-III
 - Verse

- Go to page 318 (Proper of Seasons)
- First Reading (Scripture)
- Responsory
- Second Reading (non-Scripture)
- Responsory
- Te Deum, p652
- Concluding Prayer, p318/321
- Acclamation: Let us praise the Lord, and give him thanks (p654)

Order of a Day

 - Morning Prayer
- Office of Readings
 - God (+) come to my assistance...
- Evening Prayer
 - * God (+) come to my assistance...

- Invitatory
 - Office of Readings
- Morning Prayer
 - God (+) come to my assistance...
- Evening Prayer
 - God (+) come to my assistance...
