

Grant us penetrating minds to understand, a retentive memory, method and ease in learning, the lucidity to comprehend, and abundant grace in expressing ourselves.


Guide the beginning of our work, direct its progress, and bring it to successful completion.



Back to....Proper of Saints

- ***Gives directions/instructions for the differences for that particular Saint Day
- Follow the directions of the Solemnity / Feast day except otherwise noted.
- You will place a ribbon in the day you are praying, and continually return for directions
 - Sometimes a lot of directions
 - Sometimes only a little

 - **NOTE:**
 - OOR 2nd Reading
 - MP: Antiphon for the Canticle of Zechariah
 - Concluding Prayer
 - EP: Antiphon for the Canticle of Mary

- * NOW ...
- Common of Holy Men, p 1812
 - * NOT A SOLEMNITY, so no EP I so move to page 1818
 - NOTE: will use EP-II for your EP
- * **EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING...on page 1880-
 - OOR Scriptural Reading USE
 - BUT Use Non Scriptural reading from SVdP p1426
 - MP: Antiphon for Canticle of Zechariah
 - BUT Use Antiphon for Canticle of Zechariah from SVdP
 - Concluding Prayer - BUT use from SVdP, p 1424
 - EP: Antiphon for Canticle of Mary
 - * BUT Use Antiphon from SVdP, p1426


