Daytime Prayer

- Go to 4-Week Psalter for the Liturgical
 - **Week**
 - then **Day**
 - then **Time of day** (mid-morn, mid-day, mid-afternoon)

Daytime Prayer

- Start with the Introduction
 - God + come to my assistance, Make haste to help me.
 - Or - the Invitatory IF this is FIRST LOTH prayer of YOUR day
- NEVER SKIP the Hymn

Daytime Prayer

- Psalmody
 - Psalms given in the 4-week Psalter
 - **BUT** Antiphon (*singular*) given in **Proper of Season**
- Reading
- Verse
- Concluding Prayer
- Acclamation: *Let us praise the Lord, And give him thanks*

Daytime Prayer

- DID YOU NOTICE: Only one set of Psalms were given in the 4-week Psalter for Daytime Prayer
- If you do another Daytime prayer: Use **Complementary Psalms - p 1191**
 - Only ONE SET each for the 3 Daytime prayers
 - For **midmorning**: Ps 120, 121, 122
 - For **mid-day**: Ps 123, 124, 125
 - For **mid-afternoon**: Ps 126, 127, 128






 - several -1370;
 - one - 1395
 - Common of Virgins, p 1468

Proper of Saints

- Go Slow, Be Patient
- Mark pages BEFORE you begin to pray
- Use markers: Ribbons, Prayer cards, etc.
- Prepare the 4-Week Psalter for the day
 - AND the Commons for the Saint


